

## CONSERVATION CORNER

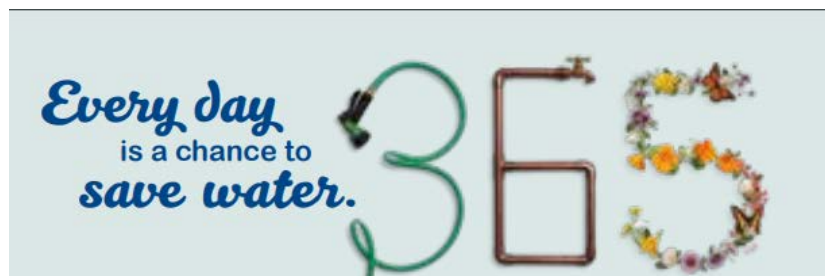
**Are you looking to transform your yard in to a long-term beauty while saving water?**

Metropolitan Water District's Landscape Transformation program is being offered as a new program designed to promote water use reduction and sustainability. The new Landscape Transformation Program aims to combine turf removal, irrigation modification and rainwater retention or filtration to support reuse or soil absorption of rainwater.

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California has changed the Landscape Transformation Program (Turf Removal Program):

- increased the rebate to \$2/square foot
- increased the square footage they'll rebate (both CII and residential sites)
- lessened the number of plants per 100 square feet of turf removed
- no longer REQUIRING front yards before back yards
