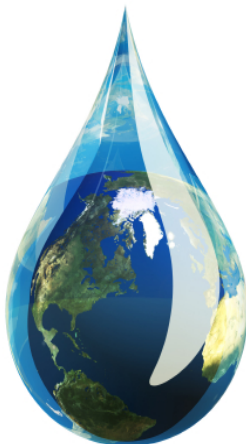
- Workshop is open to K-12 Teachers (if you have not participated in a Project WET workshop in the last 36 months)
