1. A regular meeting of the La Verne Senior Advisory Committee was called to order at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, May 18, 2022.

Unfinished Business

2. Senior Nutrition Program: For the Grab-n-Go meals, there was an average of 117 participants per week in April.
3. Guest Speaker: Abby Pascua, CEO, Aging Next. Abby spoke about the programs available through Aging Next. Their purpose is to educate seniors to be able to stay home and live independently. They provide various programs including Volunteer Drivers for seniors aged 60 plus. They find drivers to take individuals to doctor appointments, grocery shopping or lunch with a friend. There is also a program where the individual finds their own driver and they will reimburse mileage at 40 cents per mile. They also have a Memory Care Center that provides respite for caregivers and also provides social activities for the individual. Americorps provides funding for RSVP Volunteers. Other programs include: Care Partners, a Resource Specialist, and a partnership with Claremont to provide case management to residents. Additional programs are listed in their packet of information.
4. Bingo Report: There were new attendees last week and an average of 44 players per session in April. Power Ball has been very popular. The equipment is working okay but the adapter on the computer needs to be replaced. Volunteers are still needed. \$905.00 was deposited into the account and expenses for paper totaled \$1,000.00. The current Bingo balance is \$3,655.18.

5. Meals on Wheels: 717 meals were served to 42 La Verne recipients in April.
6. Account Balance: \$4,480.14.
7. Senior Program Fees: Bridge and Woodcarvers are not paid. Scrapbooking is doing well; they meet the last Tuesday of every month.
8. MT. SAC Classes: The Request to Register period for summer classes was held throughout the month of May.
