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COMMUNITY SERVICE INFORMATION

There are numerous citizens who voluntarily serve on commissions and committees to advise the City Council on the many issues of concern in our growing community.

From time to time, members retire or leave their commission/committee posts and new members must be appointed. Also, new issues are raised and whole new committees are formed to address the issues.

This is where you come in. As a citizen of La Verne, you are eligible to serve on any commission or committee – your only qualifications are interest, motivation, desire, and of course, the time to serve. Your service will be voluntary and without pay.

Appointment to a commission or committee is by the City Council, and your responsibility is to advise the City Council on those issues that fall within the responsibility of your commission/committee.

Most commissions and committees meet once a month or as the need to deal with critical issues that arise. The City of La Verne is strong due to its citizen involvement. We encourage you to get involved and help in the furtherance of the life style La Verne has become noted for.

If you wish to be considered for a community service position, please fill out the application attached and designate your areas of interest.

For your assistance, we have listed the current commissions and a brief statement of their purpose.

PLANNING COMMISSION Meetings: 2nd Wednesday of each month – 6:30 p.m., City Hall

Purpose: To oversee and insure high quality development within the community; to carry out goals, policies and objectives as set forth by the City Council; to insure compliance with the Zoning Ordinance and the General Plan.

YOUTH SPORTS COMMITTEE Meetings: 1st Wednesday of odd numbered month - 6:30 p.m., City Hall

Purpose: To advise the City Council and the Parks & Community Services Department on the scheduling, maintenance and use of athletic facilities by youth sports organizations and school teams.

SENIOR CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE Meetings: 3rd Wednesday of each month -10:15 a.m., Community Center

Purpose: To plan for coordinated delivery of services to senior citizens to eliminate duplication and conflict of effort, as well as to inform its seniors of the availability of programs.

YOUTH AND FAMILY ACTION COMMITTEE Meetings: 4th Tuesday of each month - 6:30 p.m., City Hall

Purpose: Functions as the community's catalyst in developing and implementing programs to help young people avoid destructive influences and behaviors such as drug and alcohol abuse, gang activity, academic apathy, etc.

CITIZEN OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE-Measure LV Meetings: Feb, May, Nov and as needed - City Hall

Purpose: To ensure that the revenues from Measure LV are spent in accordance with the approved spending guidelines. Applicants must be 18 years old, have resided within the City of La Verne for at least one year, and should have knowledge of finance, banking, business, or retirement planning.

ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE Meetings: Once per quarter or as needed - City Hall

Purpose: To help facilitate policies to create multi-modal transportation options specific to La Verne.

OLD TOWN LA VERNE BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT Meetings: 1st Monday of each month – 8:30 a.m., Varies

Purpose: The Board is responsible for planning and organizing promotional events and marketing materials, make recommendations on the budget, and plan for physical improvements within the Old Town La Verne District.

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
